

Runnymede Crescent Road Reconstruction Tree Impacts

Construction Administration 2020 Local Road Reconstruction Program

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Scope of Work

- Removal of asphalt, concrete curb and gutter, granular road base and existing catch basins (CBs) and CB connections
- Removal of trees as required for new construction
- Construction of new CBs and CB connections, granular road base, concrete curb and gutter and asphalt pavement
- Construction of a new 1.8 metre wide concrete curb-face sidewalk (on all legs of Runnymede Cres)

Schedule of Work

- All work will be completed during the 2020 construction season, approximately between May and November 2020.
- Work will be scheduled and staged to minimize inconvenience and impact to the local residents and neighbourhood.

Impacts to Existing Trees

- Approximately 39 trees in total must be removed for the proposed road reconstruction.
 - 37 of 39 of those tree removals are due to impacts with the proposed new sidewalk.
 - 2 of 39 of those tree removals are due to health/condition concerns with existing trees, as recommended by Forestry Operations.
- Additional tree removals may be required due to construction constraints.

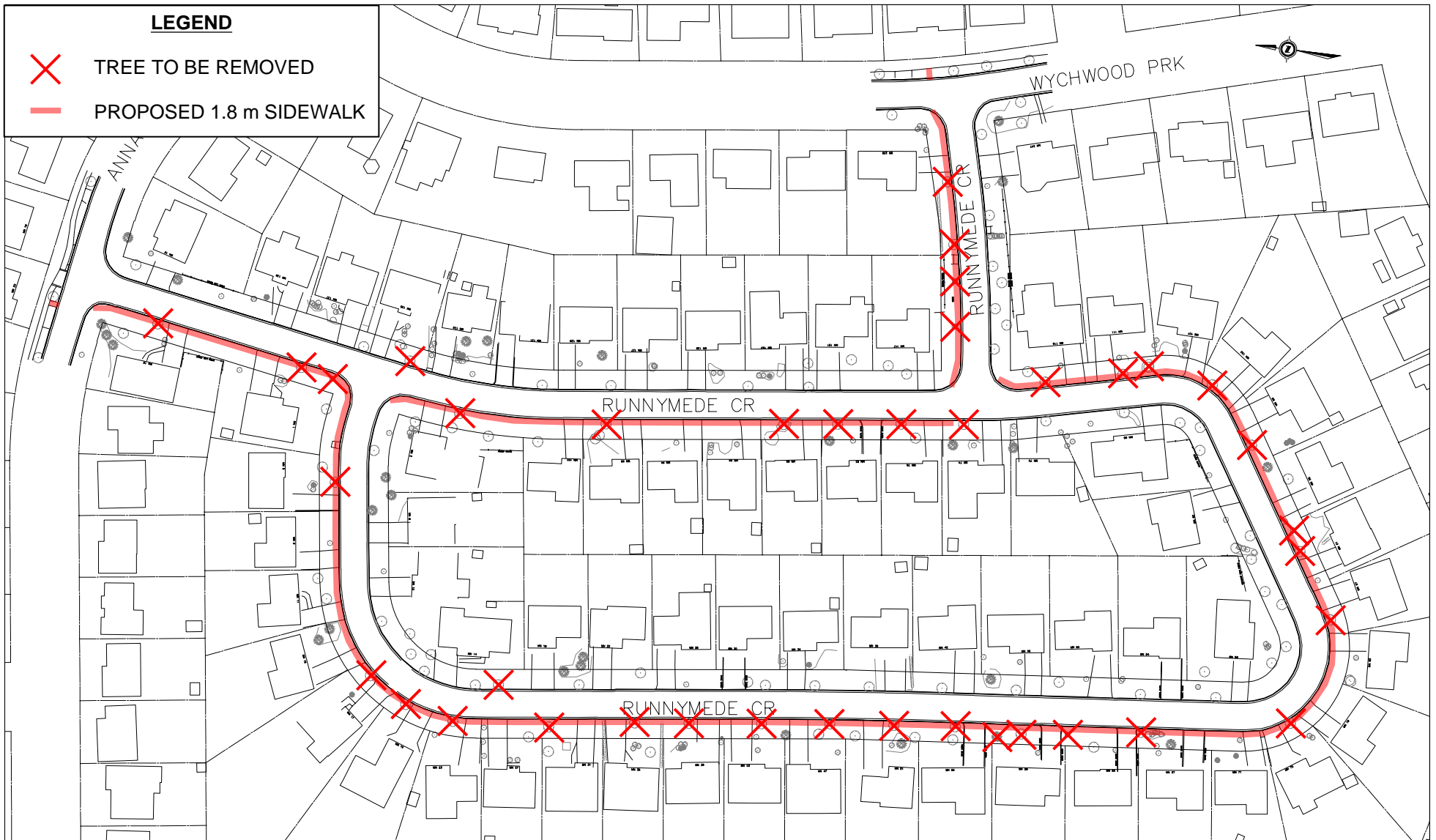
